Orentas will Serve on Panel to Study Climate Change

Arlington (Jan. 14, 2008) – Paul Orentas, managing partner for Virginia-based LiquidMaize, has agreed to serve on the Commission on Climate Change appointed by Virginia Gov. Timothy M. Kaine.

Among the goals established by the Virginia Energy Plan is the need to reduce greenhouse gas emissions via energy conservation and use of renewable energies. Orentas brings to the 32-person panel his expertise in the area of clean energy projects and biofuel investment. He is also one of the founders of LiquidMaize, which is pursuing the manufacture of ethanol and other biofuels with an emphasis on efficient distribution and convenience for customers.

Orentas served as principal investigator on four federal and state cooperative research and biofuel development initiatives. He also wrote a paper for the U.S. Department of Energy entitled, "Technology Roadmap for Marketing U.S. Biopower -- The Role of BioPower in the New Energy Business Model."
